Dear Ed

I am writing to ask for your support at the forthcoming County Council elections. This letter is to explain why I think I would be the best choice for Lower Sunbury and Halliford.

The Conservatives have run the County Council for decades and Spelthorne has been treated as the part of the County that does not matter. There are big issues in our area, and we need effective representation on Surrey County Council to get our voice heard.

We have suffered directly from the decision to dump the Eco Park on our doorstep. This incinerator was an unproven design which has cost Surrey tens of millions of pounds and is now the subject of legal action. I would work to get incineration removed from this site permanently.

We have seen several large housing developments and the government is demanding yet more. Despite these pressures, Surrey is not addressing our infrastructures needs. Our roads and traffic management are in a dreadful state, but Surrey doesn't see this as a problem. Local schools have been denied the investment they need for years, and now SEND funding is being threatened. I would work to protect local services, such as libraries, adult education and youth services and to increase infrastructure investment in our area.

As a Spelthorne Borough Councillor, I have worked hard to scrutinise the finances and get a detailed understanding of the £1bn property portfolio. I initiated a cross-party review of Spelthorne's investments which is changing how the Council approaches its schemes. At Surrey, I would do my best to make sure that every pound is spent wisely.

I have worked with my Liberal Democrat colleagues to provide constructive input to the Local Plan process, which is threatening out precious Green Belt. We have sought to persuade like-minded councillors from all political groups to shift the unimaginative thinking. I will work with any councillors who are on the same wavelength, regardless of political badges.

Surrey Conservatives have proposed that the Borough Councils are absorbed into a Surrey unitary authority. I am against moving services into a single centralised bureaucracy. We need to maximise efficiency, but any new arrangement must retain local accountability and be endorsed by residents.

I hope that you will feel able to vote for me in this election. In return I will do my utmost to make sure that the voice of Lower Sunbury and Halliford is heard by Surrey County Council.
