



**CCTV Consultation:  
New Camera Installation  
Green Street  
Sunbury-on-Thames**

Dear Resident

CCTV Cameras are a valuable tool used in the Borough of Spelthorne which to help keep our communities safe, reduce crime rates and provide evidence for Surrey Police to secure criminal convictions in the courts.

CCTV cameras have been installed in parks and town centres across the borough as part of our strategy for tackling crime. These cameras are operated from a control room by a team of fully trained staff and record 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. This is done in partnership with Runnymede Borough.

CCTV cameras have been installed with the following objectives:

- To help reduce the fear of crime
- To help deter crime
- To help reduce vandalism and anti-social behaviour
- To help detect crime and provide evidential material for court proceedings
- To enhance community safety, assist in developing the economic wellbeing of Spelthorne Borough and encourage greater use of town centre facilities
- To assist in supporting civil proceedings that will help detect crime.

At all entry points to CCTV zones, signs are erected clearly stating that CCTV cameras are in use. The locations of the cameras are also published in our code of practice.


**(Partner Signage) Runnymede (Will State Spelthorne) CCTV Signage:**



As well as a deterrent, CCTV is an excellent tool for the investigation of crime. Cameras are constantly recording and these recordings may provide key evidence in criminal proceedings.

This evidence may be used in court as part of the case presented by the prosecution or defence. CCTV can prove innocence as well as guilt.

A new re-deployable CCTV camera will shortly be installed on or near the pathway outside the no.63 Green Street, Sunbury-on-Thames (see below)



Here at Spelthorne Borough Council, we are keen ensure we have a well-defined pathway for individuals and businesses to discuss any concerns they may have, where we as an Authority, install any new CCTV asset.

This new CCTV camera is capable of Pan, Tilt and Zoom functionality (PTZ) and will be recording in high definition quality, 24 hours a day/365 days of the year.
